A couple of questions have been received about the total cost of the local share. While the total project is close to \$60.7 M, \$53.4 M qualifies for State subsidy and the local share is \$6.8 M. Donna mentioned we should ask both the Forecaster and the Times Record to highlight that the local share is \$6.8 M. We will ask all District schools to post this information on their facebook pages as well. Brad will coordinate those communications.

SAG GOP also posted an inaccurate and inflammatory commentary on their facebook page regarding the referendum and the cost of the high school project. Brad will follow up with communication which highlights the facts.
