Project and Sub-Committee Update: The project is on time and on budget. The Learning Commons and Technology Committee presented their technology plan to the Building Committee and were able to meet the \$1.1 M budget funded by the State without compromising any major features of their plan.

The Building Committee also discussed prioritizing fundraising needs that go beyond the original fundraising items included in the referendum once additional academic or athletic needs are identified.

White lockers have been chosen for the hallway and the athletic lockers will be red and blue.

Baseball parking options are being explored.

Parking, road work and site work will encompass multiple phases this summer and Donna will communicate with the school community about parking, the main entrance, and traffic flow as the plan for the summer becomes solidified. In the fall, it is planned that junior and senior students will have available parking.

Financial Update: The financial report for April will be posted. Ryan will coordinate.

Fundraising Update: The Committee is planning to recognize major donors and kick off community fundraising campaign in September. In the meantime, the Naming Rights Committee has asked that an all-district email blast be sent with a virtual tour and links for each fundraising activity currently underway.
