Meeting Minutes
July 19, 2019

June 14, 2019 minutes were approved and posted.

Shawn will remind all Sub-Committee Chairs the importance of taking minutes of all meetings and then sending them to Ryan Palmer to be posted on the construction website. Ryan will also follow up with Kathy about the June meeting minutes of the Building Committee. Financial updates are also current.

The project is 51% complete. The project is on time and on budget. Planning for vacating and demolishing the current MTA High School will begin very soon.

Ryan noted that community members occasionally ask questions on Facebook. The Committee discussed how those questions should be managed. It was agreed that Ryan would respond to questions by redirecting community members to contact John Hodge and/or Shaw Chabot.

Donna followed-up with Lyndon about whether there are any updated renderings for digital signage and renderings for interior design. Renderings of both the digital sign and interior elements of the school will be topics for future posts.

The Committee also discussed posting the latest information about the status of the baseball field. The Memo presented by Lyndon at the last Board Meeting will be posted on the construction website. The link to the “winter kill” article will also be provided. Ryan will also work with Donna Susemihl to link the video of Lyndon’s presentation to the School Board on July 11, 2019.

By Tuesday July 23, 2019 Lyndon will provide another update about the planned remediation for the fields based on the identified concerns.
